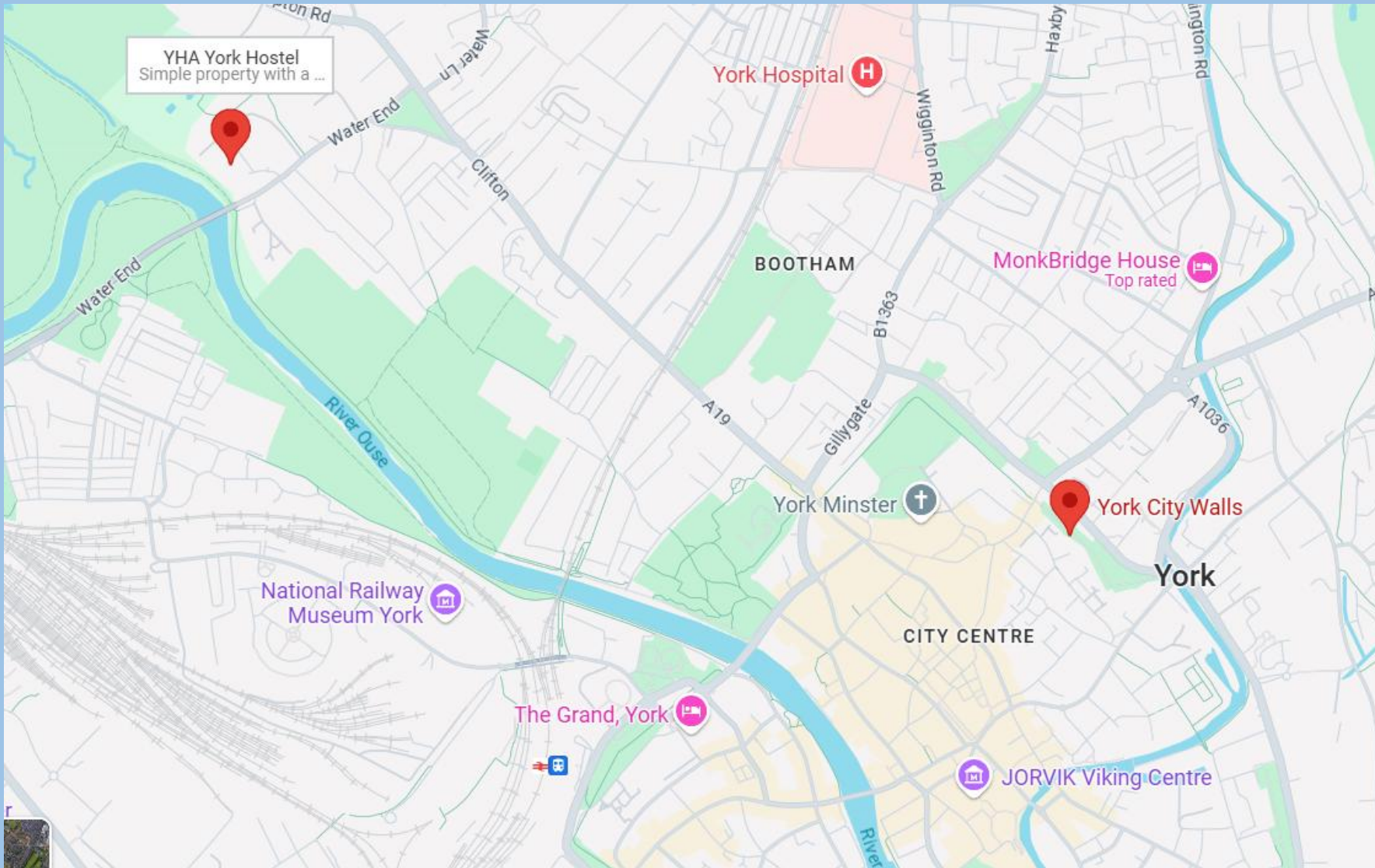

# Objectives of the visit:

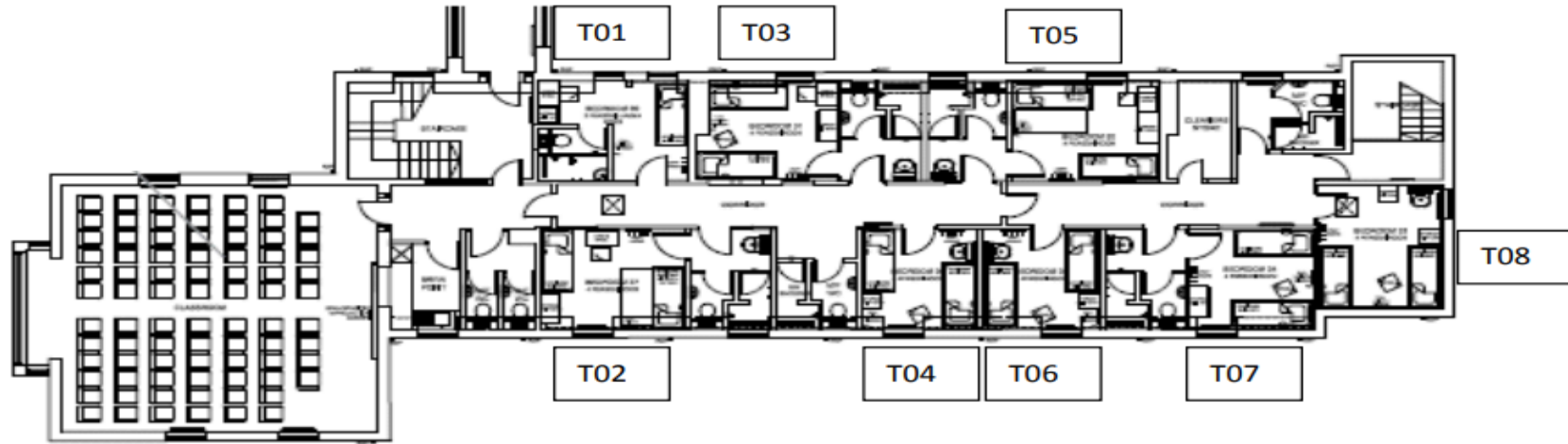


- to fulfil part of our Vikings topic in History.

- to stimulate writing curriculum.

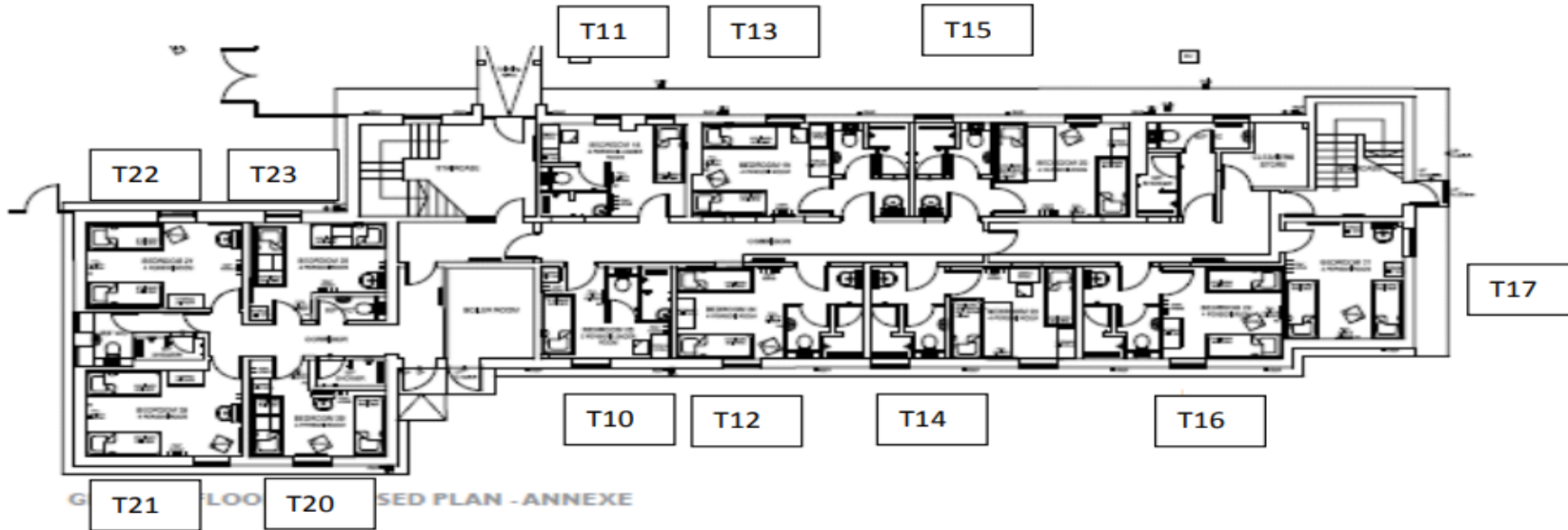
# Map
